Renowned for producing progeny of good meaty sires like the Texel, it is a hardy breed to boot, which is why it is used extensively in northern England where the climate is harsher.

British breeders imported Belgian Blues into the UK in the early 1980s and by the late 1990s, a distinctive 'British Blue' had been developed by dedicated herdsmen looking to improve the breed's genetics and characteristics for the UK dairy and commercial beef markets.
