Bruce Lau is one of the talented sculptors for the award-winning Walt Disney Classics Collection, produced by Enesco, LLC. under licence from Walt Disney Art Classics.

As a child growing up in Pearl City, Oahu, Hawaii, Lau became very interested in Disney animated films and aspired to be an animator. However, during high school, he switched his focus to sculpting. While earning his Bachelor's Degree at the University of Hawaii, Lau continued his interest in art, working in the art department of the local PBS-TV station.



Upon graduation from college, Lau attended the renowned California Institute of the Arts for a year, where he experimented in making his own eight-millimetre films starring characters made from pipe cleaners, clay and wood.

Lau began his professional career developing animation and live-action props for the entertainment industry, primarily television. His career then shifted to designing models for film, television and theme park attractions.

In 1990, Lau received a request from Walt Disney Art Classics to create prototype sculptures that would capture the charm and personality of classic animated characters and favourite film scenes for the popular Walt Disney Classics Collection.

Lau currently resides in California.
