

Celebrate the Best of British with Lilliput Lane's latest cottages

Handmade and hand-painted in Britain by a highly skilled workforce, the British Collection from Lilliput Lane features highly detailed cottages based on the nation's most famous as well as its more quirky buildings. Four new studies reveal the sheer breadth of this inspiration as well as the creativity of Lilliput Lane's designers and modellers. A former butcher's shop and a Norman church in the Buckinghamshire village of Hambleden, the harbour-side houses on Turkey Island in the Bristol Channel and the Albert Memorial Clock Tower in Belfast are the ideas behind the new studies.

Elements of the fascinating story of each building is carefully integrated into its design and so Summer Fun depicts the authentic architectural detail of the white-washed cottages at Porlock Weir on Turkey Island, and reflects its recent transformation into a vibrant holiday destination. Meanwhile, pretty and historic Hambleden village, popular with producers as a film location, has a more intimate side, as the new cottage, From This Day Forward, reveals, showing St Mary's Church as the graceful setting for a wedding scene.
