

Capturing the Nostalgia and Charm of Our Heritage, as Only Lilliput Lane Can

Hand made and hand painted in Britain, if there's one thing that **Lilliput Lane** does well, it's celebrating all that's best about being British. Here, we've selected just three of the new pieces in the **British Collection, England** range. Each captures an aspect of our national identity — fish & chips, quaint village shops and the village fête — with the nostalgia and charm for which the company is renowned.

The Salty Seagull: this fish & chips shop and restaurant has been inspired by the delightful early nineteenth century building occupying the site of No. 7, East Parade in Hastings and is just one of many lovely Victorian buildings that line this ancient town's seafront.

L3682 Lucky Letcombe: originally two tied cottages for employees of Letcombe Manor, this very pretty thatched village shop and café was opened in 2010 on the site of a recently completed retirement village in the delightful Oxfordshire village of Letcombe Regis.

L3683 Village Fête: this charming scene depicts two picturesque cottages overlooking Arkesden's Church Green where a small village fête is being held and captures so well the nostalgia of a bygone era when lemonade, cakes and coconut shys were the order of the day.
