

Border Fine Arts Contemporary Classics

Launched in June 2013, *Contemporary Classics* has been receiving some very positive reviews, and it's hardly surprising, when you look at the pieces. In these figurines the emphasis is on movement over realism, as the three new figurines — **Cockerel**, **Highland Cow** and a new black-and-white version of the popular **Collie** study (launched last year) — illustrate.

Drawing on popular subject matter from the Border Fine Arts portfolio — i.e. native wildlife — this collection has been created to offer more choice for changing times and tastes, in the form of a contemporary glazed ceramic-look finish.

Each study is entirely handmade in the company's Scottish Studios in Langholm and hand painted by highly skilled artists using a watercolour technique, resulting in slight individual differences.

Offering a fresh look for this traditional brand, the treatment of the subject, being stripped back to the raw essence of each animal, along with the natural colour palette used, ensures that this new collection will appeal to many and look good in all modern interiors.
