Situated in the heart of London, it symbolises the very heart of the nation's power and is an icon in its own right!

About Lilliput Lane

Handmade and hand painted in Britain, if there's one thing that Lilliput Lane does well, it's celebrating all that's best about being British. The company was founded in September 1982, with the aim of capturing the architectural heritage of Britain in the most authentic, detailed miniature sculptures ever seen. The fledgling company began with just seven employees. Today, Lilliput Lane has gone on to produce the world's most definitive cottage sculptures — all handmade and hand painted in their studios in Langholm, in the Scottish Borders.
