Hand made and hand painted in Britain, if there’s one thing that Lilliput Lane does well, it has to be its snowed cottages — and this year’s annual pieces will not disappoint!

O’ Christmas Tree: this rather impressive village hall serves the small Thames-side village of North Stoke and fans of the popular murder mystery TV series, Midsomer Murders, will recognise it as ‘Midsomer Wellow’ village hall, which appeared in one of the programme’s episodes. When viewed from the front, it is shaped a little like an angular Christmas tree, which is why we selected it for this year’s Christmas Hanging Ornament.

Sing a Song of Christmas: our pretty snowed church with illuminated nativity scene, porch and stained glass window has been inspired by the old Parish Church of St Peter & St Paul in Albury Park, Surrey. Although now redundant, a number of services are still held here each year.

Once again, Lilliput Lane proves that there’s plenty to sing about!
